Florida Elections in 2020

OTurnout of 11,144,855 voters

- O ALL TIME HIGH, more than 1.5 million more voters than ever before in Florida history
- O71.7% of all eligible voters, also a record
- OUS turnout overall was also a record, at 66.8% of eligible voters
 - O Nearly 160 million voters
 - O More than 20 million more voters than 2016



Over 2.2 million eligible but unregistered voters contacted
Over 214K registered, nearly 10%
Of those who registered, nearly 200K voted
Nearly 93% of all those who registered after being contacted by the state

A Very Good Election, Particularly for GOP

OGOP candidate for President won by more than 370K votes, 3.3% margin

OLargest victory for a GOP candidate at the top of the ballot since 2006

ONationally, the same

O GOP won virtually every swing district in the US House

O GOP expanded their margins in state legislatures nationwide
