

Did I check the spelling and grammar?

Best Photo Types

Types of basic photos to shoot for social

- **1. Scene Setter:** Give the viewer the big picture. Where is this action taking place?
- **2. Crowd Shot:** Show the crowd. Not many onlookers? Shoot tight.
- **3. Detail Shots:** Shoot images of any props or awards being presented.. Decorations, food etc...
- **4. Portrait:** Try to get a nice tight headshot of key speakers.
