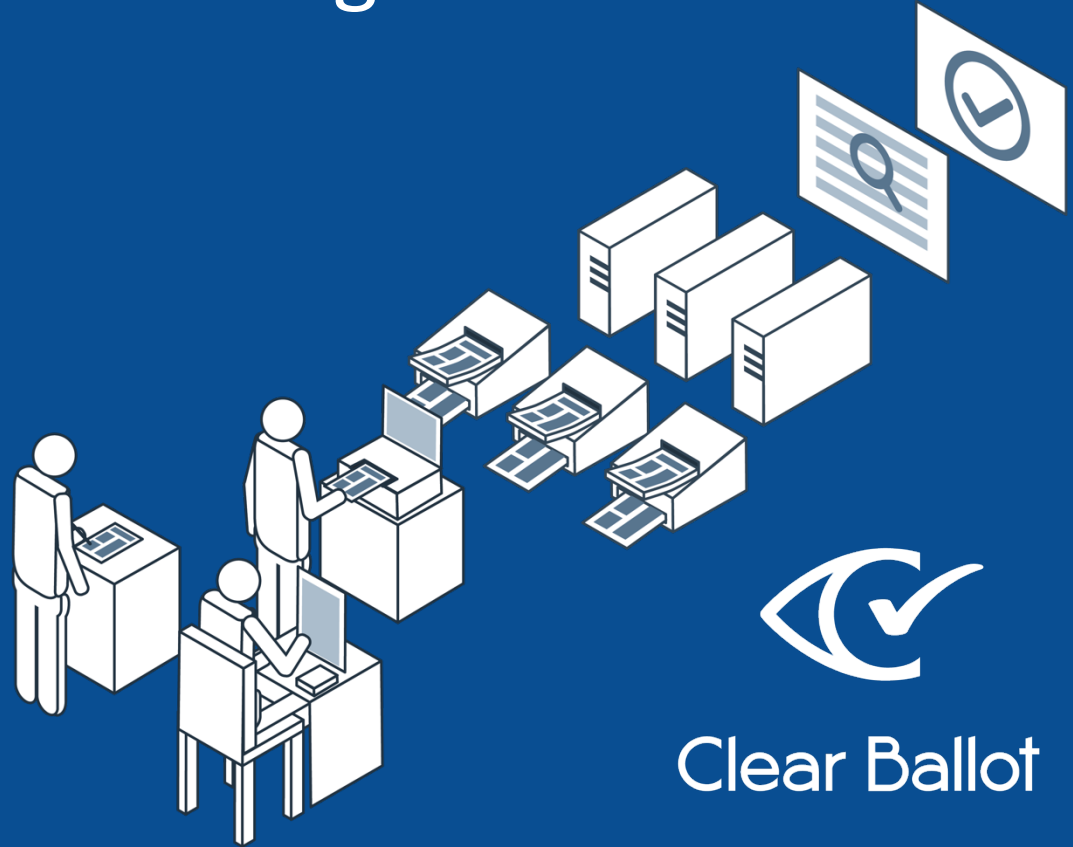
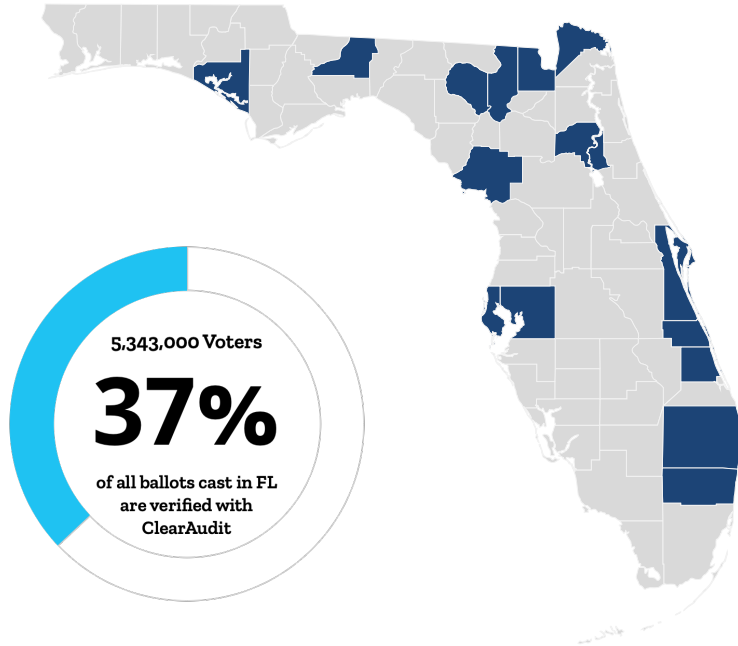

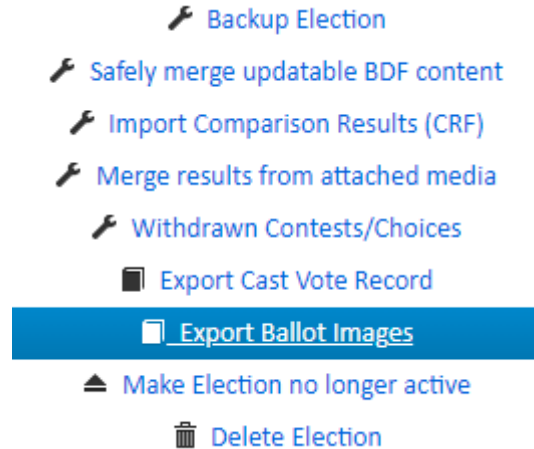
ClearCount 1.4.7 Certification (Audit & Recount)

- Target release is July 2021
- Two certification campaigns (audit and recount)
- What's included?
 - Updated COTS hardware to include the FI-7800 and FI-7900 models
 - Updated security patches for Windows 10 and Ubuntu
 - Generate comparison reports based on Florida XML results from the primary tabulation system with redacted totals
 - Ability to tabulate ExpressVote ballots natively within the system
