Dear Governor Scott:

As President of the Florida State Association of Supervisors of Elections (FSASE), I'm contacting you to request that you expedite the appointment of a Supervisor of Elections in Franklin County and Hardee County.

Both of these counties have been without a Supervisor for several months. In addition to the daily management requirements of the office there is the current legislative session dealing with Congressional Redistricting, which has the potential to impact both counties. The duty of a Supervisor, as it relates to post redistricting, involves a myriad of tasks within a very short time-frame.

The election planning and preparation for the upcoming Presidential Preference Primary has already begun by Supervisors throughout Florida, which includes Franklin and Hardee counties. Additionally, in conjunction with the ongoing elections preparation, the FSASE is coordinating the legally required new Supervisor of Elections orientation scheduled for October 5, 2015. It would be very prudent and beneficial for the new Supervisors to attend this training.

I have had numerous discussions with Secretary of State Detzner concerning these vacancies and he has concurred with the time sensitive nature of these appointments being made. As such, I would respectfully ask that the Appointment Office expedite recommendation(s) to you for your decision.
