

Florida State Association of Supervisors of Elections

Position

The Board of Directors of this corporation is composed of 5 officers, plus 10 active Board Members, each representing a district. The Board shall be considered as the policy-making body of the FSASE Corporation and shall be responsible for the formulation of the annual program to be executed by the officers.

Responsibilities

As a Board Member, it is your responsibility to initiate communication with Supervisors in your district on a regular basis to assess the issues and concerns of the members.

Board members will initiate quarterly meetings with Supervisors of Elections in your district, preferably in person, but a conference call is permissible, and provide for continued education for Board Members to ensure that responsibilities are understood and to promote engagement in FSASE business.

Leadership, governance and oversight

The Board of Directors is responsible for FSASE policy and goal setting.

The Board should make recommendations to the Executive Committee regarding pending issues and proposed FSASE activities and policies. (*By-laws [Art. IV, Sec. 6]*)

The Board shall approve amendments to the Association Charter prior to them being submitted to the general membership.

Planning administration

The board shall consider and anticipate financial needs of the Corporation and recommend the amount of annual dues for the Annual Summer Conference (*By-laws [Art. I, Sec. 4]*), in conjunction with participating in the selection of the Annual Summer Conference site. (*Procedures [Sec. I Conferences, Subsection A]*)

Board Members will work with the Budget Committee in preparation of the budget.
