



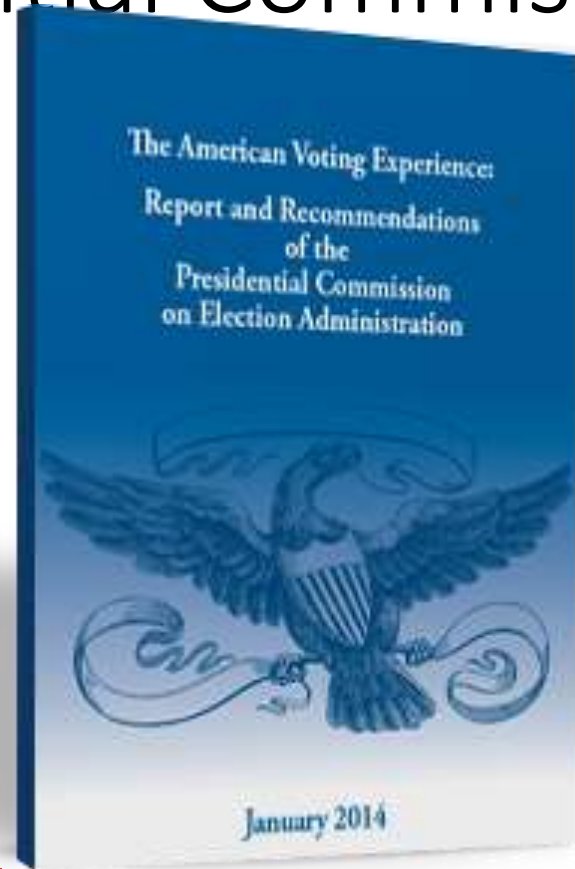

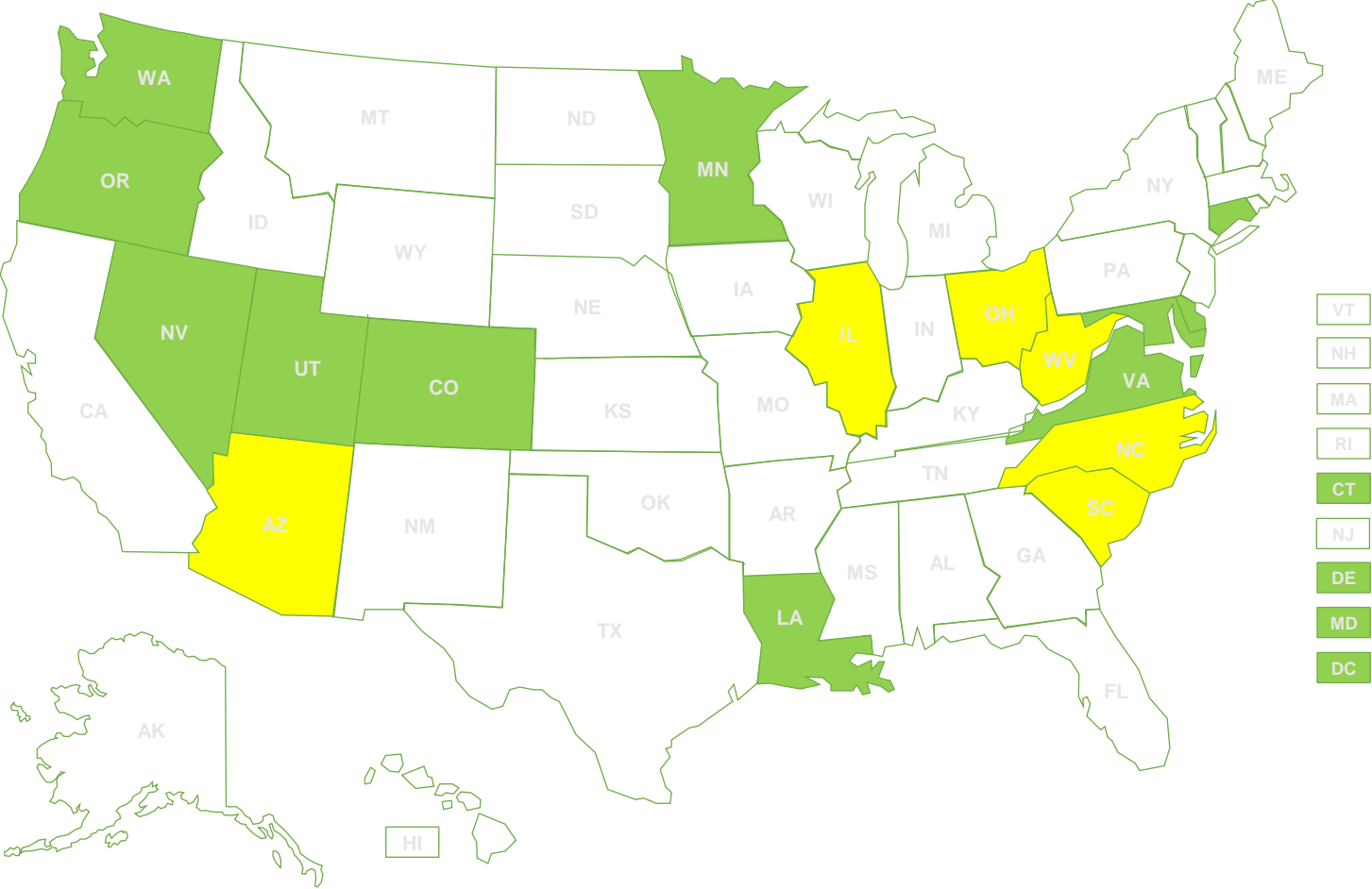

Data

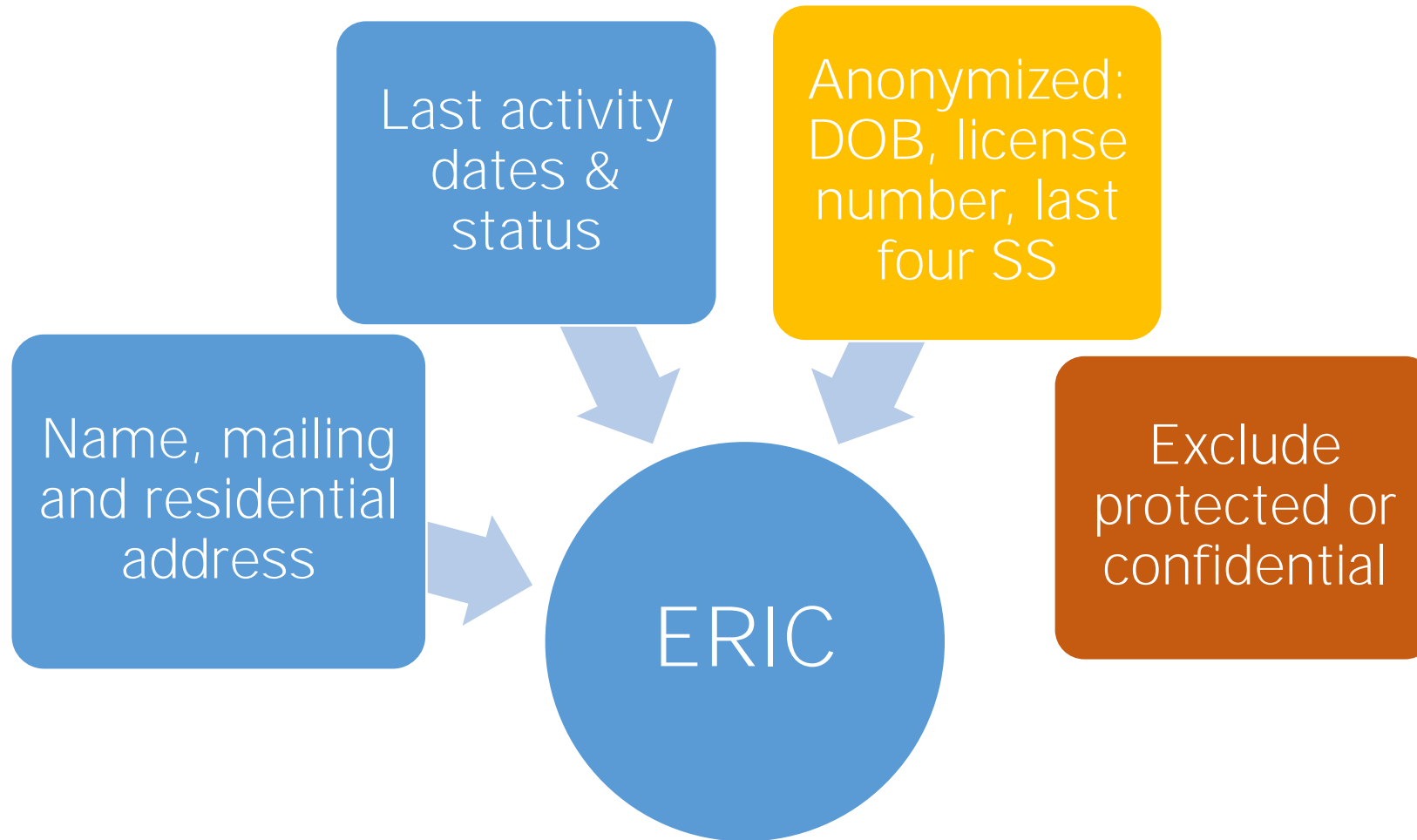
- Send data every 60 days
- Use reports within 90 days of receipt
- Each state sets specific time line
- Eligible but Unregistered before each Federal General
- Suggest list maintenance every month

ERIC report statistics as of November, 2014

Report Type	Records Sent
In-state movers More recent activity in DMV record	1,763,941
Cross-state movers More recent registration or license in other state	277,072
Deceased Appears on national death index	68,101
In-state duplicates Duplicate voter records	33,108
TOTAL	2,142,222



November, 2014 report statistics

Report Type	Records Sent
Eligible but unregistered In DMV but not registered to vote	11.6 million



Benefits to states



Savings by joint purchase of death index and NCOA services.



Cleaner rolls mean savings at election time because there will be fewer problems.



Reduced spike in registration activity at election time results in more efficient operations.



Benefits to states



A “pro-active” approach discourages “election eve matching” by interest groups.



Shows ERIC members do everything they can to keep their rolls clean and improve access to voter registration on a continuous, year-around basis.
